Ouratea hexasperma (St. Hil.) Bail.

Vernacular name: Inherezinko do Cerrado.

c. 6 km SW of Xavantina ($52^{\circ}20'W - 14^{\circ}44'S$).

Bush 2m tall with many spreading branches. Bark thick & fissured. Bright yellow flowers visited by Carpenter Bees (*Megachile*) and various Diptera.

Growing in low cerrado formation on steeply sloping N. facing hillside.
