Hirtella glandulosa Spreng.

Vernacular name: Bosta de Rato

c. 1 km. E. of Xavantina ($52^{\circ}20'W - 14^{\circ}44'S$)

Tree 13 m tall. Petals white.

Growing in cerrado by a dried-up stream.

The vernacular name (= rat's dung)
refers to the appearance of the fruit.

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
