Sloanea guianensis (Aubl.) Benth.

Vernacular name: Urucurana

Vale de Sonhos (c 80 km. S. of XAVANTINA (52°20'W -
14°44'S) on the Xavantina - Aragarças road).

Tree, 16 m tall, with small high buttresses.
Trunk c. 35 cm. diam at breast height (measurement
distorted by buttresses). Bark smooth, light-grey.
Ploze: wood cream; bark very pale pink. The stamens
which form the conspicuous part of the flower are pale yellow.

Date: 5.9.1967 Growing in tall deciduous forest.
