Aspidosperma tomentosum Mart.

Vernacular name: Bolsinha.

Near the base camp of the expedition, 12°54'S 51°52'W.
Close to the XAVANTINA - SÃO FELIX road.

Tree, 6m tall. Bark deeply fissured, charred.
Bleed: pale straw. White latex copious in the fruits
but more sparse in the bleed. Trunk 10cm in
diameter at breast height.

growing in rather open cerrado near its margin
with grassy campo.
