Cheilodinium cognatum (Piers)
Vernacular name: Pitomba. A.C. Smith

c. 50 km. N. of the Base Camp of the Expedition
on the XAVANTINA-SÃO FELIX road (Base Camp
12°54'S - 51°52'W).

Tree, 8 m tall. Trunk 8 cm. diam. at breast
height. Blaze: wood yellow with brownish stripes,
bark pale pink. Petals dark brown.

Growing in dense dry forest.
