Vernonia graminifolia Gardn.

8 km NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition
(Base Camp $12^{\circ}54'S - 51^{\circ}52'W$).

Herb with shoots to 1 m tall, somewhat
branched. Thick woody underground organ.

Growing in grassy cerrado, with
scattered trees to 6 m tall; on very
sandy soil.
