FLORA OF MATO GROSSO

No. R. 1024

Piper arboreum Aubl.

8 km NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp at 12° 54'S - 51° 52'W close to the
Xavantina-São Felix road.)

Vernacular names: Pimenta longa, Pimenta de
Macaco.

Shrub, 1m 20 cm tall. The inflorescence
spikes are young and not full grown.
Growing in valley forest on the banks
of a stream.

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
