Ferdinandusa speciosa Pohl
8 km NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp at 12° 54' S - 51° 52' W close to the
Xavantina-São Felix road.)

Vernacular name: Princesa de Agua

Shrub, 2m tall. Flowers deep red,
hence the vernacular name (=water beauty).

Growing at the water's edge of
a Swamp.

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
