Palmae

9 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina).

Vernacular name: Macaúba.

Forest Palm, 4 m tall. Pinnate
leaves approx. 2.5 m long.

Growing near the edge of a valley
forest on rich soil where cerrado species
are starting to occur. This Palm is regarded
Date: 18.4.1968 as an indicator of good soils.
