Rudgea viburnoides (Cham) Benth.

9 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina).

Vernacular name: Sucena.

Tree, 5 m tall. Trunk 11 cm. diam. at breast height.
Bark: wood pale cream; cambial tissue very white;
outer tissues with broad pale brown stripes on a
pale yellow background. Unripe fruits pale green.
Growing in the transition region between
valley forest on a rich soil
and cerrado.

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
