Tocoyena formosa (C.S.) K. Schum.

9 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina).

Vernacular name: *Geinipapa Boaba*

Tree, 4 m tall. 6 cm. diam. at breast height.

Bark scaling in \pm rectangular scales. Blaze:
wood straw coloured; outer tissues lighter coloured
than the wood, flecked with yellow longitudinal streaks.

Growing in the transition region between valley
forest on rich soil and *cerradão*.
