VERNACULAR NAME - TINGUT.

9 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina).

Tree, 18 m tall. Trunk 30 cm diameter at
breast height. Bark dark straw colour, detaching by
± angular scales, c 2.5 cm ^{thick} ~~cm~~. Blaze: wood cream;
bark pale salmon-pink with faint striations.

Growing in the transition region between
valley forest on rich soil
and cerrado.
