

FLORA OF MATO GROSSO

Guazuma ulmifolia Lam.

VERNACULAR NAME: MUTAMBA DA MATA.

9 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina).

Tree, 9 m tall. Trunk 18 cm diameter at breast height. Bark with deep longitudinal fissures. Blaze: wood white, surrounded by pale pink cortex. The wood is soft and only valuable as firewood. Growing in valley forest on rich soil.

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
