Tabebuia

Vernacular names: Pau d'Arco Roxo, Ipe Roxo.
9 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina).

Tall tree, 33 m in height. Trunk 32 cm. diameter
at breast height. Bark pale, somewhat fissured.
Bleed: wood cream-white; cortex very pale pink
with a longitudinal lattice of darker tissue.

Growing in valley forest on rich soil.
