Vernacular names: Pau de Arco Amarelo, 1/2ê Amarelo.
9 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina).

Young tree, 4 m tall. 8 cm. in diameter
at breast height.

Under more or less continuous
canopy in valley forest on rich soil.
