Apuleia molaris Spruce ex Benth.

Vernacular name: Amarellão.

9 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina).

Young tree, 8 m tall. Smooth bark with transversely elongate lenticles. Blaze: wood pale straw; cortex pure white with outer thin chlorophyllous layer typical of young trees. This species reaches c 40 m tall.
Growing in valley forest on rich soil.
