(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina). Vernacular name: GUATAMBU.

Tree, 22 m tall. Trunk 40 cm diameter at breast height. Trace of buttresses at the base. Bkgs: wood white, surrounded by light brown (marzipan) rather wide cortex. Copious milky latex from twigs, leaves and fruit.

Date: 19.1.1968

Growing in valley forest on rich soil.
