Clusia sellowiana Schlecht.

9 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina).

Vernacular name: Cebola Braba.

Tree, 8 m tall. Copious white latex with
a slight lemon tint.

Growing by streamside in cerrado formation.

I think vernac. name (=wild onion) refers to
the shape of the fruits.
