(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.  
of Xavantina).

Tree, 6 m tall. Flowers and  
pedicels deep wine-red. Corollas  
fleshy.

Growing by the side of a stream  
running through Serra da formation.

Date: 21.4.1968 Vernac. name means 'Beauty  
of the Water!'
