Vernacular name: Cipo Quina Amarga.

c. 15 km. N of the Base Camp of the Expedition.  
(Base Camp  $12^{\circ}54'S - 51^{\circ}52'W$  on the XAVANTINA -  
SÃO FELIX road, c 275 km N of XAVANTINA).

Liana on a fallen tree in dry forest.  
It must have ascended to a height of 20 m  
when the tree was standing. The stem is 30 cm.  
in girth close to the base.
