Gouania diversifolia Cogn.

Vernacular name: Cabaçarana

Córrego Surucucu, 13 km N of the Base Camp
of the Expedition ($12^{\circ}54'S - 51^{\circ}52'W$) on the
XAVANTINA - SÃO FELIX road.

Climbing amongst shrubs along the margin of
a stream. Flowers examined ♂ with 2 large sessile
anthers inserted inside receptacular cup. Receptacular
cup and sepals bright orange. Corona (corolla) consisting
of 3 yellow petals.
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
