Bocageopsis multiflora (Mart.) R. E. Fries

5 km S of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ}54'S - 51^{\circ}52'W$ close to the
Xavantina-São Felix road).

Tree, 10 m tall. Trunk 60 cm in girth 1 m above
ground level, Bark deeply longitudinally fissured.
Bloss: wood dull yellow; cortex deep red-brown with
striated pattern; cork chocolate-brown.

Petals and sepals greenish cream. Anthers
non-locellate.

Date: 2.5.1968

Growing in cerrado on red,
sandy soil.
