Hymenaea stigonocarpa Mart.

5 km S of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12° 54' S - 51° 52' W close to the
Xavantina-São Felix road).

Vernacular name: Tatoba do Cerrado.

Tree, 10 m tall. Trunk 60 cm in girth
1 m above ground level. Growing in
Cerradão on red sandy soil.

This is by far the largest specimen of this
species I have encountered; usually
it is little more than a shrub.
