No. R. 1282

Emmotum nitens (Benth.) Miero

6 km S of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12° 54' S - 51° 52' W, c. 270 km N of
Xavantina). Vernacular name: Sêbro.

Tree, leaning over at an angle of 45°, 6 m tall,
but if standing straight up it would be nearer 12 m.
Trunk 28 cm in diameter at the equivalent of breast height.
Bloss: wood yellow-white, cortex pale gold-fawn; both soon
darkening - the cortex to golden velvet curtain colour.

Perianth grey.

Growing in dry forest/cerradão transition
