No. R. 1284

Styrax pallidus A. DC.

6 km S of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12° 54' S - 51° 52' W, c. 270 km N of
Xavantina).

Small tree, 2 m tall. Flowering
abundantly. Petals cream, reflexed. Anthers
deep yellow, forming a Solanum-like group
(although not united).

Growing on open ground by the roadside
cleared of dry forest / cerrado transition formation
