Vochylia rufa Mart.

3 km S of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ}54'S$ - $51^{\circ}52'W$, c. 270 km N of
Xavantina). Vernacular name: Pau Doce.

Small tree, 3.5 m tall, with broad crown.
Leaves hard & leathery, somewhat undulate at
the margins. Flowers bright yellow.

Growing in cerrado at the edge of
grassy camps.
