Mezilaurus crassiramea (Meisn.) Taub.

6 km S of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c.270 km N of
Xavantina). Vernacular name: Cumbuquinha.

Small tree, 4.5 m tall. Trunk 9 cm in diam.
at breast height. Bark deeply fissured, charred to
to nearly 3m above the ground. Blaze: wood straw-
colour^l; cortex creamy with a pale pink tint and a
brownish longitudinally-elongate patterning; cork fawn.

Growing in cerrado formation with trees to
7m tall.
