FLORA OF MATO GROSSO

Dimorphandra mollis Benth.

6 km S of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c.270 km N of
Xavantina).

Vernacular names: Faveira, Tacaramitã.

Small tree, 3.5 m tall. Bark charred almost to
the top of the tree, detaching in long scales. Trunk
8 cm. in diameter at breast height. Blaze: wood
cream-yellow; cortex yellow; cork mauve-pink.

Growing in cerrado formation with trees to
Date: 6.5.1968 7 m tall.

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
