Aeschynomene brasiliana (Poir.) DC.

6 km S of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ}54'S$ - $51^{\circ}52'W$, c. 270 km N of
Xavantina).

Herb with somewhat woody stems,
1 m tall. Flowers dirty yellow. Hand lens
examination shows stamens in two lateral
adelphous bundles, each of 5.

Growing in cerrado formation at the
roadside.

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
