Inga heterophylla Willd.

4 km. N of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54' S - 51^{\circ} 52' W$, c 270 km N of
Xavantina).

Slender tree, 13 m tall. Trunk 13 cm in diameter at breast height. Bark silvery, rather smooth. Blaze: wood yellow cream, cortex deep red. Staminal filaments (the conspicuous part of the flower) white.
Growing in dense dry forest.
