*Chrysophyllum* Poepp. & Endl.  
or *S. Proseii* Piré  
*Sclerolobium aureum* Benth.

$\frac{1}{2}$  km N of the Rio Suia-Missu Ferry (approx  
290 km N of Xavantina).

Vernacular name: Taxi

Tree, 15 m tall. Trunk 24 cm in diam. at breast  
height, slight buttressing at the base. Bark grey-brown,  
fissuring into small scales. Flowers yellow-green,  
falling soon after opening - no fruit set.

Low forest by the side of a large lake, obviously  
inundated during the rainy season.
