Ocotea aciphylla (Weed) Mez.

$\frac{1}{2}$ km N of the Rio Suia-Missu Ferry (approx.
290 km N of Xavantina).

Vernacular name: Louro Amarello

Tree, 18 m tall. Trunk 33 cm in diameter at
breast height. Ploze: wood pale yellow;
cortex sandy brown. Ploze strongly and very
pleasantly scented.

Growing in forest close to small stagnant
lakes which are drying up.
