Inga heterophylla Willd.

Vernacular name: Inga

3 km. W. of the Rio Suia-Missu Ferry
(approx. 290 km. N of Xavantina).

Tree, 12 m tall. Trunk 13.5 cm in diameter at breast height. Bark brown, smooth. Blaze: wood cream, surrounded by narrow pink cortex & a chlorophyllous layer outside. Sepals & petals green; the filaments form the conspicuous part of the flower. Flowers pleasantly scented.

Date: 13.5.1968

Growing in forest formation on sandy soil, approaching dry forest.

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
