*Humiria balsamifera* (Aubl.) St. Hil.

C4 km. N. of the Base Camp of the Expedition  
(Base Camp 12° 54' S - 51° 52' W, 270 km. N. of  
Xavantina).

Vernacular name: *Tua Preta* (= Black Berry).

Tree, 15 m tall. Trunk 35 cm in diameter  
at breast height. Blaze: wood white, hard;  
cortex orange. Blaze not scented. Petals  
white.
