Richeria grandis Vahl.

4 km W of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ}54'S$ - $51^{\circ}52'W$, c. 270 km N of
Xavantina). Vernacular name: *Taca Braba*

Tree, 10 m tall. Trunk 60 cm in girth
1 m above ground level. Bark corky, almost
5 cm thick. Wood white, soft and weak.

Growing in a swampy locality surrounded
by *Cerradao* / dry forest transition
formation.
