Rosaceae

4 km W of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ}54'S$ - $51^{\circ}52'W$, c. 270 km N of
Xavantina). Vernacular name: Pau da Agua

Tree, 12 m tall. Trunk 70 cm in girth 1 m above
ground level. No buttresses.

Blaze: wood straw-yellow; cortex dark honey-brown.

Growing in damp forest close to a
swamp.
