Tapiriscia guianensis Aubl.

4 km W of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ}54'S - 51^{\circ}52'W$, c.270 km N of
Xavantina). Vernacular name: Pau Pomba

Slender tree, 13 m tall. Trunk 50 cm in girth
1 m above ground level. No buttresses. Blaze:
wood white; cortex pale brown with sparse latex.

Growing in damp forest, close to
swampy ground.
