Mouriria pusa Gardn.

7 km S of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ}54'S$ - $51^{\circ}52'W$, c. 270 km N of
Xavantina).

Vernacular name : Pusa Preta

Tree, 7 m tall. Trunk 27 cm in diameter at
breast height; charred to 4 m above ground level.
Bark : wood pale straw colour; cortex orange-
brown, very narrow. Petals white.

Date: 23.5.1968 Fairly open cerrado with
scattered trees to 9 m tall.
