

FLORA OF MATO GROSSO

No. R. 1584

Tabeaia

Córrego de Gato, 220 km. N. of Xavantina on
the Xavantina-São Felix road.

Vernacular names: Pau d'arco roxo, Ipê roxo.

Tree, 11 m tall. Trunk 38 cm in diameter at
breast height. Blaze: wood creamy brown; cortex pale
fawn, very thick. Corollas mauve-purple with 2 yellow
markings on the lower anterior part of the throat.

This specimen was collected at the start of flowering when
leaves still present - flowering continues after leaf-fall.

Date: 30.5.68

Growing on a small wooded mound
('island') surrounded by wet grassy compo.
