Tree, 20 m tall. Trunk 180 cm in girth 1 m
above ground level. Blaze: wood white; bark
thick, sandy-brown.

Growing in valley forest on rich brown soil
with much bamboo in the understory.

Vernac. name (= pipe bearer) refers to the
