Vernacular name: Urucurana

10 km N. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54'S - 51^{\circ} 52' W$, c. 270 km N. of Xavantina, close to the Xavantina - São Felix road).

Tree, 16 m tall. Trunk 33 cm in diameter at breast height. Small buttresses. Sepals pale cream - yellow. Petals 0.

Growing in small swampy area lying
or seasonal stream in tall forest.
