4 km. N. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54' S.$ - $51^{\circ} 52' W$, c. 270 km. N.
of Xavantina on the Xavantina - São Felix road).

Vernacular name: Pinho. Vegetative Biological
Voucher.

Tree, 8 m tall. Trunk 25 cm in girth
1 m above ground level, forming a long
unbranched bole with a terminal crown of
huge compound leaves (Palm-like growth form).

Date: 19.6.1968

in dry forest - although the species
is usually found in damper places.
