

FLORA OF MATO GROSSO

No. R. 1864

Axonopus brasiliensis (Spreng.) Kuhlms.

8 km. E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54' S$. $51^{\circ} 52' W$, c. 270 km. N. of Xavantina on the Xavantina - São Felix road).

Tuft grass, 80 cm tall, not forming large tussocks.

Growing on fairly short dry grassy campo with such species as Anacardium humile.

Vigorous growth brought about by burning 6 weeks previous to collection.
