Casearia sylvestris Sw. var. lingua |
8 km. E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54' S.$ - $51^{\circ} 52' W.$, c. 270 km. N.
of Xavantina on the Xavantina - São Felix road).

Vernacular name: Olho de Pombo.

Small tree, 5 m tall. Trunk 22 cm
in girth 1 m above ground level.

Growing in low cerrado near its
margin with grassy campo.

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
