Bulbergia meyeri Mez.

8 km. E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54' S.$ - $51^{\circ} 52' W.$, c. 270 km. N. of Xavantina on the Xavantina - São Felix road).

Epiphytic bromeliad on a Rubiaceae tree; situated 1 m above ground. Bracts pale pink; sepals pale blue; petals bright green.

Growing in cerrado at the edge of a small gallery forest along a stream.
