Luhea paniculata Mart.

8 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54'S.$ - $51^{\circ} 52' W$, c.270 km N.
of Xavantina on the Xavantina - São Felix road).

Vernacular name: Acoito Cavalo.

Moribund tree with trunk snapped off 7 m
above ground level. The peculiar form of the
large inflorescence may be due to the unhealthy
condition of the tree. Petals white.

1st deciduous valley forest / cerrado
Date: 22.6.1968 transition zone.
