Guatteria coriacea R.E. Fries

8 km. NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54' S.$ - $51^{\circ} 52' W.$, c. 270 km N. of Xavantina).

Vernacular name: Embireira do Campo.

Small tree, 5 m tall. Trunk 11 cm in diam. at breast height. Bark silvery, scaling in small flakes. Blaze: wood white; cortex straw coloured with a longitudinally elongate mesh pattern.

Growing on a mound covered with cerrado vegetation, surrounded by grassy campo.
