Phoradendron

8 km. EE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54'S.$ - $51^{\circ} 52' W.$, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina). Vernacular name: *Erva de Passerinha*.

Large mistletoe, forming a clump approx.
1 m in diameter on a 5 m tall tree of
Qualea parviflora Mart. The mistletoe is
situated 2 m from the ground & the tree is
growing on a mound covered in cerrado vegetation.
Date: 24.6.1968 ('island') surrounded by grassy campo.
