Byrsonima aff. pachyphylla Tuss.

8 km. NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54'S.$ - $51^{\circ} 52' W$, c. 270 km. N. of Xavantina). Vernacular name: Murici

Wide bushy shrub, 1.8 m tall. Petals yellow at anthesis, becoming orange-red with ageing.

Growing in low shrubby cerrado close to its margin with grassy campo.

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
