Vochysia rufa Mart.

3 km. NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp $12^{\circ}54'S.$ - $51^{\circ}52'W.$, c. 270 km. N. of Xavantina). Vernacular name: Pau Doce

Tree, 5 m tall, with wide spreading boughs.

Bark white, deeply fissured, charred below.

Flage: wood white; cortex sandy-brown, rather broad.

Growing in low shrubby cerrado close to its margin with grassy campo.

Date: 24.6.1968

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
